1. Complete the relevant details on the Register screen.
2. Lifesaving online will determine whether you have registered before or are already listed on the SLSA Surfguard database and check the correctness of your email address. If you are an existing member and the email address is different, you will need to contact our Registrar to have this changed so they match. Please provide relevant information such as name, address and date of birth. This authentication is performed to ensure the privacy of your information.
3. You will be emailed a link for security purposes that you must click on to activate your account. You may then log in and access your details. Should your address, phone or email details change during the course of the season you can simply log in and update them here.

For paid shifts at functions a current Australian Business Number (ABN) will be required. Proof of registration of ABN must be provided.
